Curriculum: PRE-CHIROPRACTIC PALMER COLLEGE OF CHIROPRACTIC

Listed below is the recommended course of study to meet the prerequisite requirements needed to enter Palmer College of Chiropractic. Overall, 90 semester hours are required.

Other course selections may be acceptable; however, please check with the admissions office at Palmer College before registering for classes other than those listed.

Physics 201 and 202 Principles of Physics, L&L (prerequisite: Mathematics 112)	8

Physics 203 and 204 Engineering Physics, L&L (prerequisite: Mathematics 161)	10
<u>COMMUNICATION/WRITING/SPEECH</u> Literature courses are not recommended.	6+
<u>PSYCHOLOGY</u> Any college level course listed under the Psychology department.	3+
<u>SOCIAL SCIENCES AND/OR HUMANITIES</u> Choose a minimum of 15 credit hours from: Anthropology; Communications; Criminal Justice; Economics; Education; English; Fine Arts; Foreign Languages; History; Philosophy; Political Science; Psychology; Sociology.	15+

NOTES:

English, Reading, Mathematics (as prerequisite for Chemistry and Physics) and Chemistry Placement Tests may be required and are available in the Testing Center, located in Room 353 or call 777-0394. English and Reading placement tests may be waived if you show documentation of a proficiency level 1 or 2 on the high school MEAP writing and reading tests or if you have an ACT composite score of 22 or greater.

Students should check the M.C.C. catalog for course prerequisites.

This program is subject to revision due to additions and/or deletions in the Palmer College catalog.

Students must complete 90 semester credit hours of undergraduate studies, including the above specific courses required by Palmer.

Further, for admissions to Palmer College of Chiropractic each student must:

1. Apply one year in advance of intended starting date.
2. The minimum cumulative grade point average in the prerequisite courses and the required 90 semester hours for entrance to Palmer College of Chiropractic is 2.50 on a 4.00 grading scale. Preference will be given to students earning a 2.75 or better. The lowest grade a student may earn in any of the required prerequisite courses is a "C" (2.00).
3. Complete at least eight courses at Muskegon Community College.
4. Satisfy all other requirements as prescribed in the Palmer College of Chiropractic catalog.
