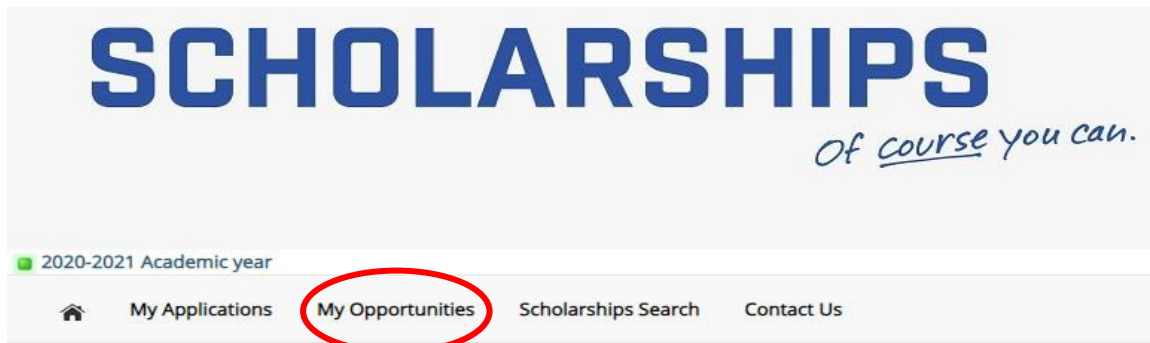

- After being awarded the scholarship, you must use the scholarship funds during the immediately upcoming Summer, Fall, or Winter semester.
- You must be a full-time student at MCC during the scholarship semester.
- You must enroll in at least one Social Sciences course during the scholarship semester.
- You must maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0
- You may not receive a cash distribution for any unused funds.
- Please submit an essay on why it is important for an educated person to study Psychology, as well as the other social sciences. Also, describe your Muskegon Community College academic achievements.
