

#### When first viewing the scholarship website you will notice:



\*You must be a U.S. Citizen, Permanent Resident, or Eligible Non-Citizen (as defined by FAFSA) to apply for scholarships




Anything that appears in **BLUE** is preloaded from your student account at MCC.





Some things to look out for when filling out an application to make sure it is complete.


1. When starting an application you will see a bar that checks your progress. The little "i" explains the bar and additional questions.




2. If you see these symbols while filling out your application, make sure you fill out the questions completely before continuing. These are required before an application can be submitted.



Ex. If you are applying for an achievement based scholarship, you will see this on the first page of applying. This means you need to answer the question before you leave the page.



3. When submitting a transcript, you do not need an official one to apply for a scholarship. Just the most recent.




#### How to obtain your unofficial MCC transcripts:

- Navigate to MyMCC
- Select the Student Planning button



Select Unofficial Transcripts under the Academics tab




• Select Student Planning Transcript, save the PDF, and upload it to your scholarship application.




4. If asked, make sure you know when you will be attending, so you will be receiving the award at the correct time.



5. If asked to put in a recommender, put in the accurate information of the person. They may have to be specific people from the college or can be people from your job or high school. You and the recommender will receive emails confirming the request.



6. If you have properly filled out the application, you can see a page review of everything to double check your work before submitting. Once everything looks good, you can submit and will receive a confirmation e-mail. After you have checked and submitted your application you will not be able to edit it any longer.
