Institutional Retention, Graduation/Completion and Transfer-Out Rates

Muskegon Community College (MCC) is pleased to provide the following information regarding the college's retention, graduation/completion and transfer-out rates. The information is provided in compliance with the Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008, as ammended. The rates reflect the retention, graduation/completion, and transfer-out rates for "First-Time in College Degree-Seeking" students. The information was originally reported to the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) on annual basis.

One-Year Retention rates are calculated for students who enter college for the first time, and are degree-seeking during the fall term. The retention rates reflect the number of students that return to the same institution during the fall term of the following year.

<u>Graduation/Completion</u> and <u>Transfer rates</u> are based on a three-year period of attendance for two-year programs, and one-and-one-half years for one-year programs. The categories do not overlap. Students who both graduate and transfer are only counted as graduating.
